## INTRODUCTION

This special supplement to the October 1990 issue of *ARGONAUTA* contains the second issue of our CNRS Research directory. For technical reasons, as well as to make it more convenient for your use, we are publishing the directory separately. We hope that you will approve and that you will find the directory useful in pursuing your individual interests in maritime history.

The directory is, we hope, easy enough to understand. For each member who responded to our requests for information we list what has been provided. The address, whether business or office, is the one which the member has suggested. Home addresses are denoted with the letter H; places of employment are signified by the letter O. Similarly, phone and FAX numbers, where provided, are differentiated by the same symbols. The descriptions of research interests and the publications included are those selected by individual respondents. Finally, we have included not only those individuals who chose to respond this year but also for completeness those who participated in our last survey in 1987 but who did not provide a new listing for this directory. The unrevised listings are indicated by the letter U after a member's name. Unrevised listings are not, for obvious reasons, included in the indices at the end of the directory. Also excluded from the indices are members who did not complete the appropriate section on the information sheet.

A brief word is perhaps also in order about the indices. We asked each member to select up to three broad areas that describe their areas of research interest or special expertise. We also asked them to select a particular chronological period and to choose up to three geographic areas that best describe their special interests. You will find these indices, which we hope will serve as handy guides to assist members in locating others with particular expertise, at the end of the research directory. All members who completed the index section of our information sheets are listed. Members indicated with a U designation are excluded.

We hope that you will find that this directory meets your needs. It is our intention to publish updates of listings (and corrections, if necessary) as space permits in regular issues of *ARGONAUTA* and to publish a completely revised research directory again in 1993. To assist us in providing even better service in future, we would welcome your com-

ments and suggestions for improvements.
