- Opening Reception starts 6:00pm August 12 at the Maritime Museum. Keynote address by Dr. Barry Gough will follow. Spouses welcome but a payment of \$ 10 at registration desk would be appreciated.
- 3. Conference sessions start at 8:30 am August 13, 14 and 15 at the Naval Reserve Base *HMCS Malahat* in downtown Victoria. Conference will close noon Saturday August 15.
- 4. Banquet/Awards Ceremony/Talk by Dr. Hadley Friday August 14 at 7:00 for 7:30 pm in the venerable Union Club across the road from the Empress Hotel. The Club's dress code calls for ties and jackets. This will be a memorable occasion.
